The Purpose of OAANY

The Okinawa American Association of New York, Inc. shall have to cooperate with the American community and to cultivate mutual friendships among the Okinawans and their families who live mainly in the five States, New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Pennsylvania and Massachusetts, and the American public who have an interest in Okinawan culture and heritage.

- 1. the Okinawa American Association of New York, Inc. is a non-profit organization that shall not have racial, religious, and sexual orientational discrimination and have no disparity in wealth and never engage in any political activities.
- 2. The Okinawa American Association of New York, Inc. shall conduct classes, seminars and workshops to promote educational opportunities in Okinawa history, culture and performing arts.
- 3. The Okinawa American Association of New York, Inc. shall provide scholarships to the young generation in order to promote higher education. The family should be at least three (3) years as member in the association.
- 4. The Okinawa American Association of New York, Inc. shall hold a General Meeting at a New Year's Party to cultivate synthetic friendships of the members.
- 5. The Okinawa American Association of New York, Inc. shall hold a Spring Party, Picnic, and Bōnenkai annually, and shall hold convivial (Get-Together) meetings as needed.

本会の目的

ニューヨーク沖縄県人会は アメリカ社会と協調して、主にニューヨーク、ニュージャージー、コネティカット、ペンシルバニアとマサチュセッツを含む5大州に在住する沖縄出身者とその家族と 沖縄の伝統と文化などに興味をもつ一般アメリカ人との相互扶助と親睦を推進するのが目的である。 他州の沖縄県人会とも綿密な連絡をとり親睦をはかる。

- 1. ニューヨーク沖縄県人会は 人種、宗教、貧富の差別を絶対にしない、そして政治にも関与しない 非営利団体である。会の性格上常に沖縄をテーマにした諸行事を行う団体である。
- 2. ニューヨーク沖縄県人会は 沖縄の歴史、文化、芸能の普及に力を入れて、その普及の場を提供し セミナーや講習会 などを開催する。
- 3. ニューヨーク沖縄県人会は 青少年の勉学を奨励し奨学金を授与する。
- 4. ニューヨーク沖縄県人会は 総会を年に一度新年新春宴会の場で催し会員の総合的親睦の向上をはかる。
- 5. ニューヨーク沖縄県人会は 新年宴会とピクニックを年行事とし、別に親睦会を定期的に挙行する。
